### **Abstract:**

The literature review on feedback will be presented, Hattie defines feedback as “Information provided by an agent (e.g. teacher, peer, self) about aspects of one’s performance or understanding, with the goal of reducing the gap between what is understood and what is aimed to be understood. The paper will also discuss the stages of learning and how effective feedback can be attained (Hattie’s four levels of feedback (task, process, self-regulation and self).
